Prevention of crime and disorder	Yes	<p>Premises opposite a cemetery that is often frequented by drinkers and drug dealers who discard bottles/cans in the surrounding area.</p> <p>The Avenue has seen an increase in discarded bottles and cans obtained from shops in the location. Having another premises selling alcohol will increase footfall and increase the number of discarded drinking containers. Residents are clearing the street regularly and will object to the license.</p> <p>I am also aware of the problems that exist at the Milton Rd garage and we would not want a repeat of the problems there.</p>
Public safety	Yes	<p>Access to the shop is through a busy forecourt and will increase the likelihood of shoppers becoming involved in traffic incidents.</p>
Prevention of public nuisance	Yes	<p>The sale of late night alcohol could increase public disorder in surrounding residential street occupied by families. Please consider noise nuisance</p>

Protection of children from harm	Yes	A park nearby could end up being the location for late night drinking and discarded bottles. Risk to children's safety from broken bottles the following morning.
