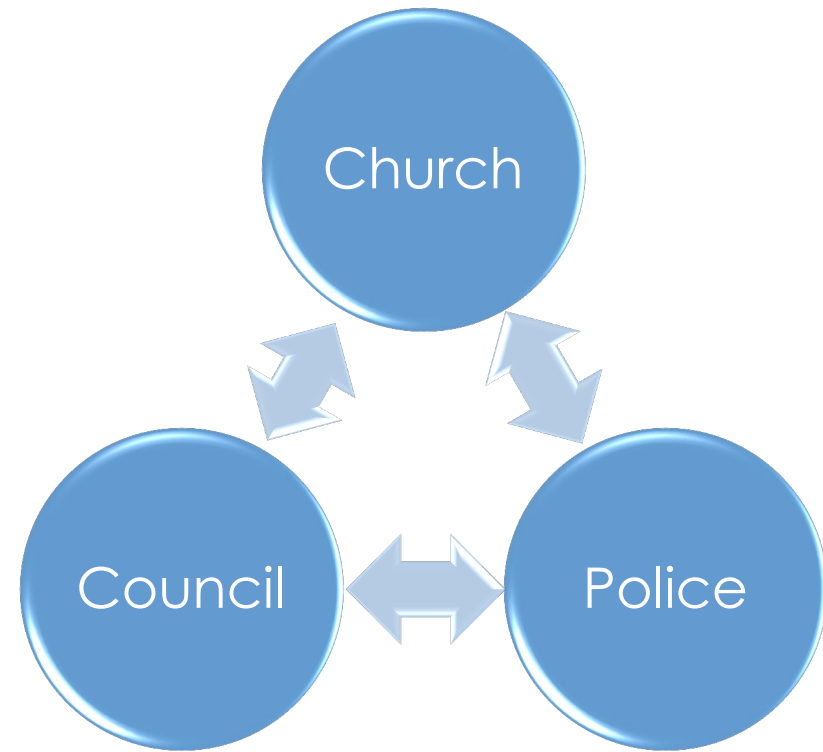

- ▣ Patrol every Friday & Saturday
- ▣ 8 teams
- ▣ Aged 26-80+
- ▣ Good working relationships with the Police, Council, doorstaff, venues, party-goers & G-SAFE.





A year in Statistics...

▣ Nights patrolled	104
▣ Volunteer hours given	2700
▣ No. of people helped	275
▣ Flip Flops given out	122 pairs
▣ Cans picked up	2374
▣ Bottles picked up	1058
▣ Antisocial incidents attended	30
