**The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment)
(England) Regulations 2020**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

Because of COVID-19 measures and subject to *The Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020*, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Albion Terrace and Norfolk Road, Gravesend.

A closure is planned from 21st September 2020 for 18 months.

Albion Terrace, Gravesend will be closed to through traffic with the exception of cyclists and pedestrians by the placement of a modular filter outside no. 25 Albion Terrace at the junction with Russell Road, Gravesend.

Similarly Norfolk Road, Gravesend will be closed to through traffic with the exception of cyclists and pedestrians by the placement of a modular filter at the junction with Prospect Grove, Gravesend.

The alternative route for traffic accessing the area is via Canal Road, Russell Road.
