Summary: This report updates Members on the identified schemes approved for construction

1. Introduction

This report provides an update and summarises schemes that have been programmed for delivery in 2020/21.

Kent County Council has agreed a substantial increase in the budget for planned highway works over the next three years, and as a result we are still in the process of identifying and designing schemes for inclusion in our full Year One to Two (2019/20 and 2020/21) and Year Three to Five (2021/22 to 2023/24) programmes. Because of this, we have decided to publish an interim programme, and to publish the full programmes later this year. For some assets this interim programme covers approximately the first six months of 2020/21, whilst for others it includes most of the works planned for the whole year.

This programme is subject to regular review and may change for a number of reasons including budget allocation, contract rate changes, and to reflect KCC's changing priorities. The programme and extent of individual sites within the programme may also be revised following engineering assessment during the design phase.

Local Growth Fund

Local Growth Fund programme update for Gravesham Borough

The Department for Transport (DfT) added £100m to the Local Growth Fund (LGF) pot in order to fund Local Sustainable Transport Fund Style schemes. KCC subsequently submitted four Local Sustainable Transport Fund (LSTF) capital bids 1) East Kent – A network for Growth, 2) Kent Thameside – Integrated door-to-door journeys and 3) West Kent – Tackling Congestion. The fourth was for Tonbridge Town Centre Regeneration, which included a highway improvements scheme in the Lower High Street as well as additional LSTF style measures. The objective of all of the capital bids is to boost economic growth by decreasing carbon emissions and reducing congestion.

The Kent Thameside, West Kent and Tonbridge Town Centre Regeneration bids were all successful. The schemes aim to:

- improve access to employment and services
- reduce the need to travel by the private car
- enhance pedestrian, cycle and public transport facilities
- improve sustainable transport connections

KCC have acquired the land from Network Rail in Barrat Row for the creation of a Bus Hub which aims to consolidate the bus stops around the Station and improve the waiting facilities for the public. All tenants have vacat the site and premises are in the possession of KCC. A Tenancy at Will has been signed by Saturn Taxis for use the forecourt fronting their former office until construction begins and the presence of vehicles will aid with securit Initial investigations identified issues with the tracking as swept paths this was investigated, and the design altered to have 4 stops in Barrack Row and Fastrack and Sapples services stopping in Garrick Street. A Members briefing paper was sent out on 3rd June to all members to inform the scheme. A meeting with the GAG took place on 3rd June followed by an engagement event on 13th June 2019, all feedback was reviewed and considered. The

design was presented to JTB in Sept 2019 and final DD's will be presented at a future Board when received. All surveys have now been completed therefore removing demolition constraints, the slope stability report has now been received and recommends that further support is required, options and cost being sought. Discussions are ongoing with NR to resolve. Layout of the scheme is now confirmed, and DD's are being finalised and will completed by the end Sept and Tender document prep in Oct. The Bus hub (Barrack Row and Garrick Street) are now one scheme and will be tendered together. Construction will commence in February 2021 with a 9-month construction period. Planning Permission is required for the Canopies/shelters and two electric bus pantographs down charging poles with cantilever arms, the public realm and landscaping has also been included. Planning documents were submitted to KCC in August 2020. KCC are working with GBC to help facilitate the future installation of a toilet facility by Gravesham, this will ensure that it does not require additional groundwork and removal of the granite paving. KCC are looking to send the Tender pack out in November 2020.

Kent County Council has been exploring better drainage management via the 'Live Labs' project in order to seek a more encompassing software platform, dedicated to the complexities of drainage, that has the functionality to support our maintenance activities in a better way. We are trialling this project in three Districts in Kent – Gravesham, Dartford and Maidstone and a report of how successful the trial is will be produced early next year.

We will soon have inspectors inspecting every drain in Gravesham which will be validated and plotted in the Kaarbontech system, which means we have an accurate plot for gully locations. We will also be also surveying a small percentage of locations to determine the connecting pipes etc as a smaller exercise on the side.

Colleagues at Kaarbontech have also taken lots of other KCC datasets and plugged these into their system, e.g. historical confirm enquiries, historic confirm jobs, flood risk zones, tree canopies, hotspots plus many others. Once the asset information collection is completed all these datasets will then been broken down and each attribute given a risk score based on how much we 'care' So for example we would give a gully that falls within a 30 year flood zone a higher score.

The system will then automate a risk score for every individual drain in Gravesham and which will form a matrix based on highest to lowest risk. We will then use this information to inform proposed cleansing regime for each drain which starts at 6 monthly up to every other year/biannually. This programme means that every drain in Gravesham will be attended at least every two years with some assets yearly/ twice yearly. The cleansing programme will commence in February 2021.

This approach is about trialling moving to a more proactive programme rather than relying on customer enquiries once an issue has already occurred. We hope this will reduce the

enquiries/flooding calls we get over time which will in turn improve customer service and also reduce the ratio in which we currently spend our budget so we spend more on cyclical 'planned' work and less on reactive work. We hope that by trialling this new way of thinking means budgets will be spent in a better way.
