Notice of determination of application for an expedited review of a Premises Licence

GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL being the licensing authority, on the 13 October 2021, received an application for an expedited review of a premises licence in respect of the premises known as The Kings Head, King Street, Gravesend, Kent DA12 2EB.

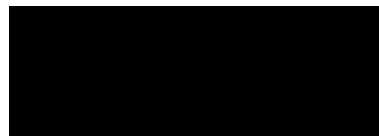
On 15 October 2021 a hearing was held to consider the application and having considered it the Council have determined as follows.

The Chair advised that, in coming to their decision, the Panel considered all the evidence presented by the Police report, the CCTV evidence and the Licence breaches including: using unlicensed door supervisors, not having the required numbers of door supervisors and refusing to provide CCTV to the police. Therefore the Licence holder has failed to up hold three of the Licensing objectives namely the prevention of crime and disorder, the protection of public safety and the prevention of public nuisance. The Panel believed that in the light of the breaches there was a continuing risk to public safety if the premises continued to operate.

Having considered all those matters and advice given, the Panel suspended the Premise Licence with immediate effect lasting until a Licensing Panel Hearing to review the Premises Licence is called within 28 days.

Note: The premises licence holder may make representations against the interim steps taken by the licensing authority. There is no time limit for the premises licence holder to make representations on the interim steps, although in practice this would need to be completed within 28 days of the application being received by the licensing authority when the full review hearing will take place. On receipt of such representations, the licensing authority must (if the representations are not withdrawn) hold a hearing within 48 hours of their receipt.
