No supply of alcohol may be made under this Premises Licence at any time.

**Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule and also agreed with Responsible Authorities**

1. Bins are provided to the exterior of the premises to allow clients to dispose of rubbish
2. CCTV must be installed at the premises and working at the premises to the satisfaction of the police and council in accordance with the Code of Practice issued by the Information Commissioners Office. Recordings are to be maintained for at least 31 days. If the equipment fails, the police and the council must be informed as soon as possible and immediate steps taken to put the equipment back into service.

3. At all times whilst trading there must be a person able to operate the CCTV equipment and be able to view the recorded information held within the equipment and upon reasonable request be able to give an authorised officer from the police or council a copy of the recording under and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1990.
4. Notices are to be placed and displayed on the door and tills advising that CCTV is in operation.
5. When the premises are open for trading after 23:hours, the premises licence holder will clearly identify a person who is accountable for the business. This person will be present in the premises until the business closes for trade
6. At all times if trading beyond 23:00 these premises must employ two Security Industry Authority door supervisors. these door supervisors are to be dedicated to the role and not just working on the premises. They are to remain on the premises until the premises are clear of all members of the public. All door supervisors must ensure their badges are being worn and displayed whilst working and wear reflective clothing that can be easily and clearly identifiable on CCTV.
7. A notice should be provided informing the public that food is not to be consumed in taxis.
8. Prominent clear and legible notices will be displayed at the exits asking customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.
9. An incident book is to be maintained at all times and any incident relating to crime and disorder reported to the Police immediately.
