Following the recent correspondence received we have reviewed our risk assessment taking your email into consideration.

We have already cancelled our DJ's we had booked for Christmas Eve and New Years Eve, as we understand the importance of keeping our noise levels to a minimum

We have employed a bar manager and with the help of a family friend who works in compliance, I am confident that you will see the positive changes that will be happening over the coming months.

We have already started works within the kitchen area and had booth areas installed within the Cricketers to create food seating areas.

We would be more than happy for you to attend so you can see these positive changes are being made and that we are moving in the right direction of making the Cricketers into a more food focused establishment

The following amendments have been made to our detailed Risk Assessment and summarized as follows:

- To prevent the noise disturbance no further Live bands or DJ's to be held on the premise
- Juke box can be on as long as the level of music is kept at a range that does not cause disruption to our residents and should be checked from outside the premises at regular intervals and diarized accordingly
- Speaker in the garden is always kept low and completely turned off at 8pm Sunday – Thursday and 10pm Friday & Saturday.

Again, we are extremely sorry for the issues that have previously occurred but please be assured we are putting every measure we can in place to ensure this does not happen going forward.
