Regarding this Licence variation.

we are concerned that the significant extension to the premise's hours would cause an increased risk of noise nuisance and anti-social behaviour to local residents. We would therefore object on these grounds to the hours requested in the attached application.

We would however be willing to accept a slight amendment to the hours. We would recommend 06:00 – 23:00 Monday to Sunday. These times are chosen as they closely match similar shops in the area. This recommendation would mean that they gain two hours earlier per day in the week and four on the Sundays. The recommendation also mean that on Sundays they get a further 30 minutes at the end of the day. Please let us know your thoughts.
