We object to this notice under the Licensing Objective – “The prevention of public nuisance” for the following reasons:

This premises under Mr Manik’s ownership has caused numerous confirmed noise nuisance to local residents that led to service of noise abatement notices and a license review. The licensing panel placed various restrictions on the premises license aimed at reducing the likelihood of a noise nuisance. Despite this we still received a verified and justified noise complaint the first weekend the premises reopened after its license was suspended for three months, and subsequently in July. Mr Manik continues to not take responsibility for these nuisances and

blames local residents of being malicious by complaining. As the premises does not appear to be operated by its current management under normal day to day operations, we have no faith that a music event at the premises will be managed appropriately and this will lead to justified noise complaints. On this basis we feel allowing the event does not meet the licensing objectives of preventing public nuisance and crime/disorder and therefore object.
